You must have a thorough knowledge and understanding of community alarm calls handling equipment, back-up systems, peripheral equipment and be able to demonstrate at least two years' direct experience of working within a community alarm environment, which includes calls handling, database management and general experience of the installation of dispersed alarm equipment in clients homes.

You should preferably have at least 2 years' supervisory management experience, be able to confidently lead staff in emergency situations and ensure a high standard of customer service is maintained at all times.

You will, on occasions, be expected to work unsociable hours and you must have and maintain a full driving licence.
